The IMO Med-Select Network[®] will provide services to seven counties in the Dallas-Fort Worth metroplex. The network service area is comprised of Dallas, Tarrant, Denton, Collin, Hood, Rockwall and Wise counties. These seven counties constitute 23% of the Texas population.

Certified workers' compensation networks were part of the reform package entitled HB7 and passed during the last legislative session in response to medical costs and over-utilization in the Texas workers' compensation system.

IMO Med-Select Network[®] is already planning to enlarge its service area with additional metroplex counties, as well as counties in other parts of Texas, in early 2007.
